Cortona – Microsoft's person digital assistant

Why search from within a folder versus the entire computer -you know the file is in that folder somewhere

To filter search results from the Search tab of File Explorer, use the commands in Refine Group

In Windows 10, where is the main search box feature located – Taskbar

Search Engines don't filter out inaccurate results in a search. The sites could be bogus.

Intellectual Property -a work created by the mind

Plagiarism – taking someone else's work as though it was your own

Patent – protects an invention from unauthorized use or copying

Trademark – corporate logos, names, characters, etc.

Copyright – laws used to protect artwork, software, music, films, etc.

Fair Use – allows use of copyrighted material for a limited purpose

Creative Commons – license that a creator can put on their creations that limit how people use it

Public Domain – where copyright items go when their copyright expires – can be freely used without restrictions.

Search engines - Google and Bing

buffalo site:nationalparks.org – If you wanted to just search this particular site for buffalo.

In the Search tab Refine group:

Music or Contact is found under Kind Large or Empty files are found under Size Today or This Week are found under Date Modified Folder Path or Type are found under Other Properties

If you wanted to search for vehicles, but not cars, search vehicles -cars

When Google thinks you are shopping, it places pricing information toward the top.

In Windows File Explorer, you can search the current folder, all subfolders, or the entire computer.
