4/3/20 - Final Product Must Be Finished –This is on a case-by-case basis-I have emailed a couple of you, but here are some of the adjusted assignments:

Justin-you have enough hours in with your mentor, so just make sure you have the other requirements for shadowing finished:

- •Keep a detailed job shadowing journal with an entry for each time you shadowed (which will be included in the senior project binder)-This can be jotted down in a notebook or typed out in your journal on your weebly.
- Write a job shadow reflection essay (which will be included in the senior project binder) **Type one page** in Word double-spaced.
- Complete an interview with the mentor (which will be included in the senior project binder)-already handed in
- Include Job Shadow Verification Form filled out by mentor (which will be included in the senior project binder)-If he has already signed this and you have it, great! Otherwise, you could possibly mail it to him with a stamped self-addressed envelope so he can mail it back to you.
- •Research the occupation and create a presentation with facts such as average pay, education required, etc.-I don't have access to your folder right now, but next time I go to town I will check to see if it is in your folder.
