


For this assignment, you will be creating a final Premiere Pro video. You will use your own pictures and/or videos, so you need to start gathering them into a folder on your desktop. Your video has to follow a theme, such as My Senior Year or My Life (from birth to graduation) or My Family, or another theme of your choosing as long as you email me and I approve the topic. The final video should be at least 4-5 minutes long, longer if you want. This assignment usually requires 8-10 minutes, so I have cut it in half because of the distance learning. If you are only using still photos, and planning for a 4 minute video, plan about 5-6 seconds per photo which would mean about 40 photos. If you are using only videos, you need to have at least 10 videos. In other words, I won't accept a project that is just one long 4-5 minute video clip. The number of still photos might vary because we will be adding transitions and titles before we are done.

For starters, this week you need to start gathering your photos and videos and downloading them if you need to. Save them all to a folder on your desktop. Then start the assignment below with at least 15 photos if you're only using photos, or 4 videos if you're only using videos, or a mixture of photos and videos to equal 15 total.


If you have more pictures/videos gathered, you may put them all in, but you are only required to put in what is stated in the previous paragraph.

Once you have the photos/videos gathered, start the assignment in Premiere Pro.


Click the New Project button.




Name it Final and click Browse.




Navigate to your folder on your desktop where you are saving computer files. When you get to the file you want to save it in, click Select File.




Click OK




You may close the Learn panel on the left. Click the three little lines.




Click Close Panel.




Locate your pictures in the Media Browser. Start in the C: (Windows) folder.




Then double-click on Users.




Find your folder and double-click on it.



Find Desktop.



Find the folder where you have stored the pictures and open it.



Choose the pictures you want in your video and drag them onto the timeline. You may use still images or videos or some of each. Rearrange them in the order you want them to be on the timeline.

Save the Premiere Pro folder and submit the Premiere Pro file to me in Google Classroom.

This is just the beginning of this assignment. Next week we will continue working on it, adding and rearranging, and adding titles, transitions, and music. Start thinking ahead what song you want to add, and let me know if I need to download it for you.
